Acceptance of Terms. The web site WWW.ELECTRICCOOPTODAY.COM (and any other web sites re-directing users to WWW.ELECTRICCOOPTODAY.COM) and the Content (as defined below) available through this web site, including associated or linked sites (collectively referred to as the "Site") are offered to subscribers ("you" or "user") by ECT and NRECA (the "Sponsor") (collectively referred to as "ELECTRIC CO-OP TODAY" or "ECT"). By using this Site, and any Content (as defined below), you are subject to the following Terms of Use, as well as any posted guidelines, rules or policies posted herein, or any Terms of Use set forth on WWW.COOPERATIVE.COM, and incorporated by reference herein (collectively these shall be referred to as "Terms of Use.")
